Purpose for Research on Race and Ethnicity


Concerns have been raised for several decades:

- Concern about non-response over decades, particularly among Hispanics not reporting a race response
- Numerous campaigns and lobbying of the U.S. Census Bureau and the U.S. Congress by key stakeholders and public for changes to the race and Hispanic origin questions
- Growing "Some Other Race" population since 1980
- "Some Other Race" now the 2nd largest race group in the country
- Qualitative research and focus groups found that respondents expressed confusion and frustration with the separate race and ethnicity questions

Our team responded by conducting research and outreach:

- Extensive engagement with stakeholders, advisors, and the public
- 2010 Census Race and Hispanic Origin Alternative Questionnaire Experiment (AQE)
- 2014 AIAN Research
- 2015 National Content Test (NCT)
- 2016 ACS content test
- 2017 Census test



2010 AQE Methodology: National Survey with Oversample

- 15 experimental questionnaire panels
- 2 control questionnaire panels
- Mailed to national sample of housing units
 - about 30,000 per panel
 - about 500,000 total
- Design focused on oversampling of various race and ethnicity groups in mail survey
- One-in-five housing units from mail survey were selected for a reinterview study
- Conducted 67 qualitative focus groups, with about 800 people across the country, including Puerto Rico, Alaska, and Hawaii





2010 AQE Main Research Findings

Results for the Combined Question

- Did not reduce Hispanic, Black, American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander
- Reduced reporting of Some Other Race (from 7% to under 0.5%)
- Reporting of White in combined question reflects levels of Non-Hispanic White from separate questions approach
- Yielded lower item nonresponse rates
- Increased detailed reporting for most groups, but decreased for others
- Better reflects self-identity, per reinterview

Results from the AQE Focus Groups

- Fair, equitable treatment for all groups with a combined question
- Middle Eastern and North African participants did not see themselves in the current race/ethnicity categories and recommended a separate Middle Eastern, North African, or Arab response category



Foundation Laid by 2010 AQE Research

Research was foundational

- Research identified several promising ways to improve our race and ethnicity questions so that they better measure our nation
- Qualitative research and ongoing conversations with stakeholders across country revealed many Americans view "race" "ethnicity" differently than in decades past


Established three key goals to improve race ethnicity data to address race ethnicity reporting issues and racial/ethnic community concerns

- Increasing accuracy and reliability of reporting in major race/ethnicity categories
- Lowering item nonresponse rates
- Collecting detailed data for myriad groups




2015 NCT Methodology: National Survey, Oversample, Reinterview

- Large, nationally representative sample of 1.2 million addresses, including Puerto Rico
- Evaluate and compare different census content
- Refine estimates of national self-response and Internet response rates
- Continue testing different contact strategies for optimizing self-response
- Overall response rate 51.9%
- Extensive reinterview






2015 NCT Oversample



- Large, nationally representative sample of
 1.2 million addresses, including Puerto Rico
- NCT sampling methodology was designed to measure content testing differences for relatively small population groups.
- This enabled us to make comparisons for groups such as Afro-Latinos, detailed groups being considered for the MENA category, and detailed groups in multiple communities






Race/Ethnicity Distributions by Question Format: 2015 NCT

(Percent Alone or in Combination)

Key results from testing a combined race and ethnicity question format:

- Reporting of Hispanic ethnicity was higher when using the combined question format
- "White" dropped to levels reflecting the "Non-Hispanic White" population that we see in traditional separate question approaches
- "Some Other Race" became one of the smallest response categories, demonstrating that a combined question approach is more in-line with how Hispanic respondents view themselves
- Like the 2010 AQE, no changes to other major race groups (e.g., Black, AIAN, etc.)





Percent Race Distribution for Hispanic Respondents by Question Format: 2015 NCT

Key results from testing a combined race and ethnicity question format:

- Large differences in Some Other Race alone and Two or More responses – due in part to differences in how Hispanic responses must be coded and edited, but mainly to how Hispanics answer separate race question
- For people who want to just report they are Hispanic, many struggle with how to answer separate race question. Roughly 70 percent of Hispanic respondents on combined question identified as Hispanic alone. The 2015 NCT reinterview confirmed that this is how they prefer to self-identify.
- The 2015 NCT followed 1997 SPD 15 guidance when using a combined question, multiple responses are encouraged; collect both race and ethnicity when feasible; but one response is acceptable



Key results from testing a combined race and ethnicity question format:

- No differences in Hispanics identifying as Black when comparing separate questions (blue bar) with all combined question formats (red bar and green bar)
- But specifically focusing on optimal combined question with detailed checkboxes format (green bar), a higher percentage of Hispanics identified as Black than in the two separate questions format (blue bar)
- No clear differences in reporting of American Indian or Alaska Native between separate questions (blue bar) and combined question formats (red bar and green bar)



Key results from testing a MENA category:

- People who identified as MENA used the MENA category when it was available – nearly 80 percent
- People who are MENA had trouble identifying as only MENA when no category was available
- The nationalities and ethnicities in the 2015 NCT working classification of MENA identified as MENA when the category was available





Note: 95% confidence intervals are depicted by the vertical black lines at the top of each bar.




Detailed Reporting for Selected Groups by Presence of MENA Category: 2015 NCT

Key results from testing a MENA category:

- The *left side* of this figure shows that many of the selected groups (for example Lebanese and Moroccan) report most frequently in the White category (represented by pink bars), when there is no MENA category present
- The *right side* of this figure shows where detailed responses were reported when a *MENA category was included*. When a MENA category is available, the detailed groups shown report in the MENA category (represented by orange bars)







2015 NCT Methodology: Reinterview

- Content reinterview with subsample of NCT respondents, to measure accuracy
- About one-in-eight respondents from initial survey were selected to participate in reinterview by phone
- Reinterview response rate was 56.5%

Probed more extensively into the racial/ethnic background of respondents

- Ascertained respondents' "true" racial/ethnic identity for comparison to their initial responses
- Open-ended question that asked "What is your race, ethnicity, or origin?"
- Series of yes/no questions for each of the major race/ethnicity categories
 - Each "yes" response prompted a question asking for the detailed origin
 - Additional follow-up question for those who said yes only to Hispanic question



Consistency of Reinterview and Self-Response by Race/Ethnicity Group by Question Format


(Percent Alone or in Combination)

For those who identify as a given group based on reinterview, how many identified in same way in initial self-response phase?

- Largely, results were very similar across different question formats, with few differences. This is a good thing. We want to be able to elicit the same responses at different points in time for each of our census data collections.

 We did see significantly lower level of consistency for Hispanic of State Constitution (Constitution of Constitution of Constit
- respondents, between the separate questions compared to the combined question with detailed checkboxes.
- Some bars are lower for smaller groups, such as AIAN, MENA, or NHPI, in part because these groups tend to be smaller in population size and more multiracial (e.g., someone who at one point may identify as White and Native Hawaiian, at another time may just want to tell us they are Native Hawaiian).

Question Format: Summary of 2015 NCT Findings

Combined question with detailed checkboxes design appears to elicit higher quality data on race and ethnicity for the decennial census and the ACS, supporting results from 2010 Alternative Questionnaire Experiment

- White population distribution dropped to levels reflecting non-Hispanic White population
- Decreased Some Other Race reporting
- No changes to other major race groups
- Hispanic ethnicity reporting was higher
- Lower item nonresponse for combined race/ethnicity question than for separate race question
- Same or higher level of detailed reporting
- Higher overall consistency for Hispanics



- If a respondent reports that they are both Hispanic <u>and</u> AIAN in a combined question format,
- then they are counted as both categories, for the Hispanic population and for the AIAN population:
 - Hispanic and AIAN
 - Hispanic alone or in combination
 - AIAN alone or in combination
- This concept follows the same logic with multiple race reporting in the 2000, 2010, and 2020 censuses
- Our research shows a combined question yielded more accurate and reliable data, especially for multiracial and multiethnic populations





What 2020 Census Results Tell Us About Persisting Problems with Separate Questions on Race and Ethnicity in the Decennial Census

- 49.9 million people identified as Some Other Race, surpassing Black population as second-largest race group
- 33.8 million people reported multiple race groups, up from 9 million in 2010
- White and SOR largest combination at 19.3 million people

- 53.0% of Hispanics identified as White alone in 2010, compared with 20.3% in 2020
- 42.2% of Hispanics reported responses that were classified as Some Other Race alone in 2020, compared with 36.7% in 2010
- 32.7% of Hispanics reported multiple groups in 2020, compared with 6.0% in 2010





Hispanic Race Reporting and Nonresponse: 2010 Census and 2020 Census

A large proportion of Hispanics did not report an OMB race group in 2020 (43.6%), just like in 2010 (43.5%)

Many Hispanics reported their Hispanic origin as their response to the race question, which are classified as "Some Other Race" (30.5% in 2010 and 35.4% in 2020)


13.0% of Hispanics in 2010 and 8.1% in 2010 2020 did not answer the separate race question at all

While 47.4% in 2010 of Hispanics identified as White alone in 2010, 17.6% did so in 2020

2020 showed changes in the reporting of multiple race groups by Hispanics, such as 28.6% reporting White *and* SOR compared to 2.7% in 2010

Where Are We Now? Understanding 2020 Census Results to Inform Race and Ethnicity Improvements

- Extensive research and outreach over the past decade, with two groundbreaking national studies, on how to improve the collection of race and ethnicity information.
- Findings showed a combined race and ethnicity question with multiple detailed checkboxes and a dedicated Middle Eastern and North African category is the optimal design for improving race and ethnicity data for the decennial census and the American Community Survey.
- The Census Bureau continues to support OMB during its review of the 1997 Race and Ethnicity Statistical Standards: Co-Chairing Interagency Technical Working Group (ITWG); race/ethnicity experts serving on ITWG and providing support; engaging with stakeholders and public to discuss research findings.
