
September 2022

Methodology

This nationwide poll was conducted September 9-12, 2022 using the AmeriSpeak® Panel, the probability-based panel of NORC at the University of Chicago, on behalf of The Leadership Conference Education Fund.

Online and telephone interviews using landlines and cell phones were conducted with 1,003 adults. The margin of error is +/- 3.97 percentage points.

Which statement comes closer to your view:




Below are statements about college admissions. For each one, please choose whether you strongly agree, agree, disagree, or strongly disagree with it. **NET AGREE**

All students, no matter their race or background benefit from college campuses that reflect the diversity of who we are as


College admissions that look at the whole student, not just their test scores, help achieve racial equity in higher education.

We need racial diversity in addision to diversity of students' economic backgrounds to achieve true equality


Due to racial inequality, government action is necessary to level the playing field.




Below are a few statements about diversity in education. For each one, please indicate whether you strongly agree, agree, disagree, or strongly disagree with it. **NET AGREE**




